### Things You Should Know . . .

Haig Point is a private residential community and golf club and many of its members live on the property full time. We all take special pride in the appearance of our grounds and buildings. Your consideration of the facilities and environment is both expected and appreciated.

### Alligators

Part of the allure of the low country is the proximity of the natural environment and the critters that inhabit it. Please note that it is illegal to feed the alligators.

- Exercise caution around the lagoons. Remember, alligators are in their habitat and they are wild.
- Always observe them at a distance.
- When fishing in our lagoons, alligators may be attracted to the activity created while reeling in the fish.
- Be aware when retrieving golf balls gone astray.
- Please respect their home.

**Carts . . .** are to be driven only by licensed drivers aged 16 years and over. Proper care and safety precautions while using the cart are your responsibility. Carts are not allowed on the Daufuskie Island Beaches.

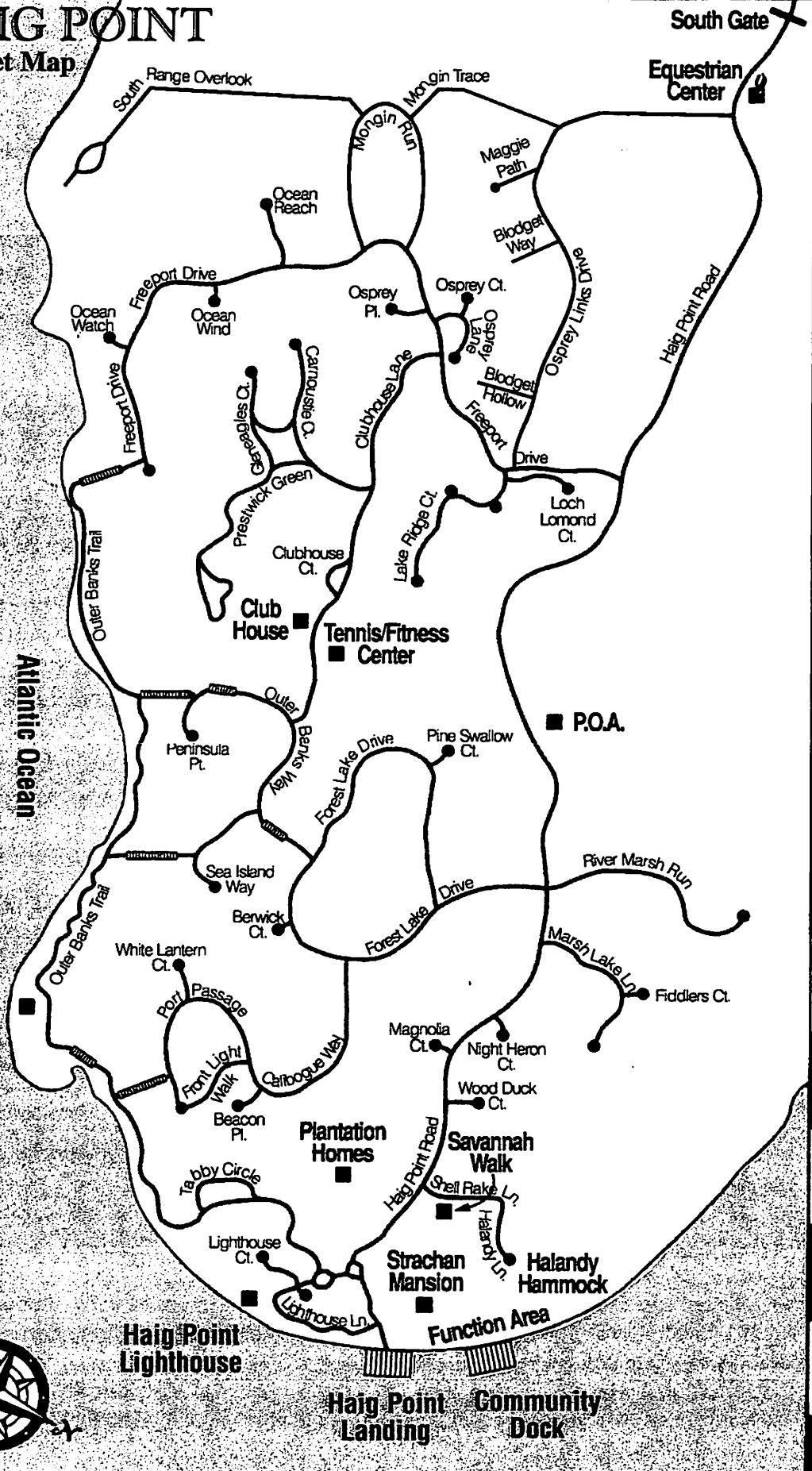
**Cell Phones . . .** may be used outdoors except on the golf course. Enjoy the sounds of nature while at Haig Point. Cell phone usage is not allowed in the cabin of the Haig Point Ferry.

**Dress . . .** is casual but neat. Bathing attire is permitted only at the Beach Club. The ferries require proper cover-ups. Proper golf attire is required on the golf course. Whites are preferred at the tennis courts and smooth soled shoes are required. For dining, jeans are only permitted in the Mansion and 30<sup>th</sup> Hole Grill at lunchtime. Evening events may require a jacket for men in the Main Dining Room upstairs at the Club House.

**Ferry . . .** departures from the Welcome Center on Hilton Head begin at 6:30 am and run every hour until 10:30 pm at 30 minutes after the hour. Departures from Haig Point begin at 6:30 am and continue until 11:40 pm at 40 minutes after the hour. Departures are prompt! Please arrive at the ferry at least 10 minutes prior to the departure time to allow time for boarding. Use caution on the docks, ramps and while moving about on the vessels.

**Smoking . . .** is not permitted per county ordinance on the ferries or in any of the club facilities.
